Project Highlights

- 98kW photovoltaic ground array generation system for new maintenance shop and office complex in Winslow Township, New Jersey
- The solar ground array will generate over 125,000kwh of electricity on an annual basis which will account for approximately 70% of the complex's electrical energy needs
